Chapter 1. Lesson Plans and Activity Ideas

Ideas for Individual Activities

This section contains wordsearch activities that students can work on individually. They can be done in class or given as homework activities. These activities are not set out as full lesson plans. They are ideas to add variety to your wordsearch activities.

Traditional Wordsearch

Traditional wordsearches are commonly used as warmers or fillers.

In the traditional wordsearch you give the students the wordsearch grid and corresponding word list. Students find the words from the list in the grid.

You can add an element of competition to a traditional wordsearch by setting a time limit and having a prize for the student who finds the most words in that time.

Things you will need:

- Copies of the wordsearch grid for each student;
- Copies of the word list for each student;
- Pens, pencils, or markers for the students to use;
- Clock, stopwatch, or timer.
